Additional Notes

A total of 240 ECTS credits of courses are required to graduate. The International Business students must complete technical and non-technical elective courses to provide a total of 240 ECTS credits. Otherwise they will not be deemed to fulfill the conditions to graduate from the program.

Important Information about the Elective Courses

The students of the International Business department must take 5 technical elective courses to graduate.

These courses must be selected from the Technical Elective Courses list. Courses that are not in this list cannot be accepted as technical electives.

ECTS credits of elective courses should be equal or greater than the credits specified in the curriculum.

ECTS credits of GEC/GCE courses should be equal or greater than the credits specified in the curriculum.

* The International Business students must ensure that while selecting a new technical, GEC or GCE elective course, it should not be the same, similar or less comprehensive as any course you have previously taken in your curriculum or any compulsory course in your curriculum that you have not taken yet. In this case, the courses you have taken will not be counted as any elective courses and will not fulfill any qualifications in the curriculum.
